We are very pleased to present an outstanding schedule of programs and two Saturday workshops this year. We're going hands-on in a couple so that we are doing a little, at our meetings, not just sitting/listening/knitting.

First up, in September, Kate Broughton (www.loomandessence.net) will present a program on fabric origami. Her lecture/demo will also include a small hands-on project, so that we can try out what she is showing us. So, we will sit at tables and do a little hand sewing. Please bring one or two 5 " squares of fabric and one or two 4" fabric circles, plus a needle and thread and 4 small buttons. I think this will be a fun activity, a little out of the ordinary.

Our second hands-on program will be in November. Trish Hodge of Batik Tambal (www.batiktambal.com) will present a lecture/demo using Shiva paintstiks with her Indonesian copper tjaps to make batik stamp rubbings. She will bring the paintstiks and stamps, we will do the rubbings. This activity will flow nicely with her Saturday workshop on November 20 in which we can use these rubbings and/or other panels to make a small wall hanging. Trish's forte is in how to incorporate panels into a well-designed piece. We will begin sign-ups in September for the November workshop, so please check out Trish's website for more information. I am very excited about this opportunity to learn from and work with Trish; my sources tell me she is a talented artist with a unique twist. The workshop fee will be \$40.
