TIP OF THE MONTH

When you finish sewing the binding on your quilt, you inevitably have extra binding left over. Put the extra strips in a container with plastic drawers. Label each drawer a different width size, ex: 2 ¼", 2 ½", etc. Then sew like widths together for the binding for another quilt.

The same tip can be applied to squares of fabric, or wider strips. Eventually you'll have enough strips or squares for a charity quilt, scrap quilt, etc.
