More Before Demo at the January meeting

Susan Monsegur will demonstrate how to use the Go! Cutter to cut fabric into specific shapes. Susan has the following dies: 2.5" strip die, a circle die (2", 3", 5" circles), a feather (1 7/16" x 2 3/4") and teardrop (1 3/8" x 2 7/16) die, and a 4.5" square, a 2.5" square, and a half-square triangle die that when sewn makes a 2" square. If anyone would like Susan to demo using their fabric (and therefore get their shapes perfectly cut), please bring in your fabric to cut.
