The Quilt Side

These last few weeks I have been gathering my projects for summer vacation, cutting like mad, and storing in bags. The log cabin block has come back on my radar (inspired by the Pilgrim/Roy collection) for a quilt for one grandson. The last quilts the boys received were five years ago. They have grown more sophisticated in their taste. The second grandson's quilt will be all triangles using the 60 degree ruler.

I finished a UFO that had been sitting in my drawer for 10 years. I needed to add fused pieces to the completed background and could not figure out how until listening to Kathleen Murphy's description of Misty Fuse and the Goddess sheet. The quilt is now done with a new binding technique, also inspired by her.

Each piece of the binding matches the quilt background; desert sand, mountains and sky. It is not as hard as it sounds and gives the effect of the design bleeding out to the edge.

Sometimes what you take away from a speaker is not a specific quilt you want to replicate, but a detail that surfaces months later.
