Your quilts will not go into bags until you bring them on Thursday, October 24th 8-10 am for registration. Quilts should be folded so the label is accessible.

At our Wednesday, September 18th meeting we will put together our themed raffle baskets and have the clipboards with signup sheets available. If you have already signed up, you can review when you have volunteered to work. If you have not signed up, now is your chance! Thank you to Maura Cain for taking the lead on the themed raffle baskets. It takes many volunteers to help set up the show, work during the show, and take down and clean up after the show! There is free admission into the Quilt Show if you work at least 2 shifts. Please think how and when you would like to help.
