As I was preparing for classes I'm taking at the MQX Quilt Festival during the next few days I was struck with how fortunate we are to have so many quilt related happenings in our area. I have never taken classes at MQX New England nor even attended the event and have totally stepped outside of my "box" by registering for all machine guilting classes ranging from quilting on a domestic machine to quilting on a Sweet 16. When speaking with a non-quilter friend about my up-coming classes, she innocently stated, "I thought you knew everything about quilting. Is there really more you could learn?" I had to laugh. Can we ever really know it all? New tools, techniques, fabric designs and books are continuously coming on the market and showing up at the quilt shows, quilt stores, and internet. Participating in classes and mingling with other quilters at the exhibits is such a treat for me. Who knows, maybe I will come away with a new love (and hopefully new skills) for machine quilting!

My challenge to you this month is to look at the list of quilt "happenings" in our area or maybe even an area you will be traveling to and see if there isn't an event that sparks your interest. A great website for checking out the events is **www.quiltersresources.net** which will allow you to search by state. No matter if you are looking for a large international quilt show or individual guild quilt show you will find plenty to choose from at this site.

Looking for a new project? If you haven't already begun working on your challenge quilt for the guild this year, it's not too late. The plan is to showcase these challenge quilts at our June meeting. The theme for the challenge is "Celebrate what CPM means to me". The finished quilt should not measure more than 100" around, should incorporate the numbers 3 and 5 (representing our guild's 35th birthday), and incorporate the color coral.

CPM CRAFT YARD SALE

October 15, 2016 St. Matthew's UMC, Acton 9:00 AM - 2:00 PM.

Spring Cleaning time is a great time to organize your crafty supplies and sort through your stash. If possible, we would appreciate it if you could pre-measure and mark. We measure to the nearest 1/4 yd. If it is slightly under, it is marked the lesser yardage. Less than a 1/2 yd is NOT a 1/2 yd, and would be marked 1/4 yd.

We mark and sell by 1/4 yd, 1/2 yd, 3/4 yd, 1 yard, 1 1/4, etc. NO other measurements other than Fat Quarter -- 18" x 22".

A normal quarter yard would measure 44" x 9". Less than 1/4 yd will be placed on the scrap table. If in doubt, please mark your fabric with a "?"

We accept all fabrics, yarns, and craft notions. Please do not give us dirty, bug infested fabric, or wool fabric with moth holes. Also, no clothing. UFOs (quilt or wearable) are accepted. We reserve the right to discard unusable fabric or notions.

Watch for a notice for when you can start dropping off your contributions to the church basement. There is another big yard sale in May at the church, so we are limited with what we can accept until then.
