Don't Touch the Quilt Sign Project

We are making quilted signs to use at our upcoming quilt show. Please think about making one for donation to the guild.

Guidelines:

- Quilted signs should be approximately 8x10", big enough to be seen, but small enough to not compete with the quilts on display.
- Use your imagination to get the message across but remember we always want to be polite to our visitors and appropriate for a general audience. If you're not sure about your sign, check with a friend.
- Use any quilt technique you prefer, like fusing, painting, applique, etc. Your choice!
- Finishing the quilt can be as simple as sewing it in the pillowcase style (as used in the Quilt-a-thon comfort quilts) or using a fancy binding. Your choice!
- These will be donated to the guild for the 2026 Quilt Show but will be used at future shows. Don't forget to put your name on the quilt somewhere (front or back) for posterity.
